Conversations with Lacan brings a unique, non-partisan approach to the works of Jacques Lacan, linking his psychoanalytic theory and ideas to broader debates in philosophy and the social sciences. This work demonstrates how it is possible to see the value of core Lacanian concepts, including alienation and separation, après-coup, and the Lacanian doctrine of temporality, without being defined by them.

Arguing that criticism of psychoanalysis for a lack of scientificity should be accepted by the discipline, Benvenuto suggests that the work of Lacan can be helpful in reconceptualizing the role of psychoanalysis in the future.
